Directions to Wayland Town Center (6:30 pm) and to Wayland Town Offices (7:00 pm):

Parking is available at both locations. In the town center, people should park at the western end of the site (access off rte 20 across the street from Russell's Garden Center. Park behind and west of Middlesex Bank). The Town Building is near the intersection of Routes 20, 27, and 126. We would leave the town center, heading east on rte 20 to the next traffic signal, turn right/south (onto rte 126/27), and then almost immediate right again.
